

## **LATIN AMERICAN JUDGES AND PROSECUTORS MEET IN BUENOS AIRES**

*8 October 2003*

As part of the Programme on Implementation and Compliance on Environmental Legislation, FARN, UNEP, the World Bank Institute and Law for a Green Planet Institute organised in Buenos Aires a Symposium for Judges and Prosecutors. During three days, the participants (judges, prosecutors and environmental law experts mainly from Latin America and the United States) met in plenary and in workshops to discuss, analyse, find solutions and propose recommendations for improving the implementation of and compliance with environmental legislation in Latin America. The IUCN Environmental Law Programme (ELP), a member of the Programme's Advisory Group, participated in the event. Dr. Alejandro Iza from the IUCN Environmental Law Centre (ELC) made a presentation on the IUCN-UNEP Judicial Portal, which was launched at the UNEP Global Judges Symposium held last year.
