

ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT OF WATER RESOURCES IN ARGENTINA

10 October 2003

Within the framework of a collaborative project, FARN (Foundation on Environment and Natural Resources) and the ELC organised in Buenos Aires the last of a series of workshops on baseline legislation for environmental protection. This last workshop aimed at promoting a debate on the Law 25.688 on environmental management of water resources among the various participants representing different levels of the government (federal and local), the NGOs, the private and academic sector. The discussions centred around critical issues for the implementation of the said instrument such as the jurisdiction of the federation and the federated states (Provinces), and the establishment of basin committees. In addition, it included other environmental issues such as groundwater protection, flows regulation and the transboundary dimension.
